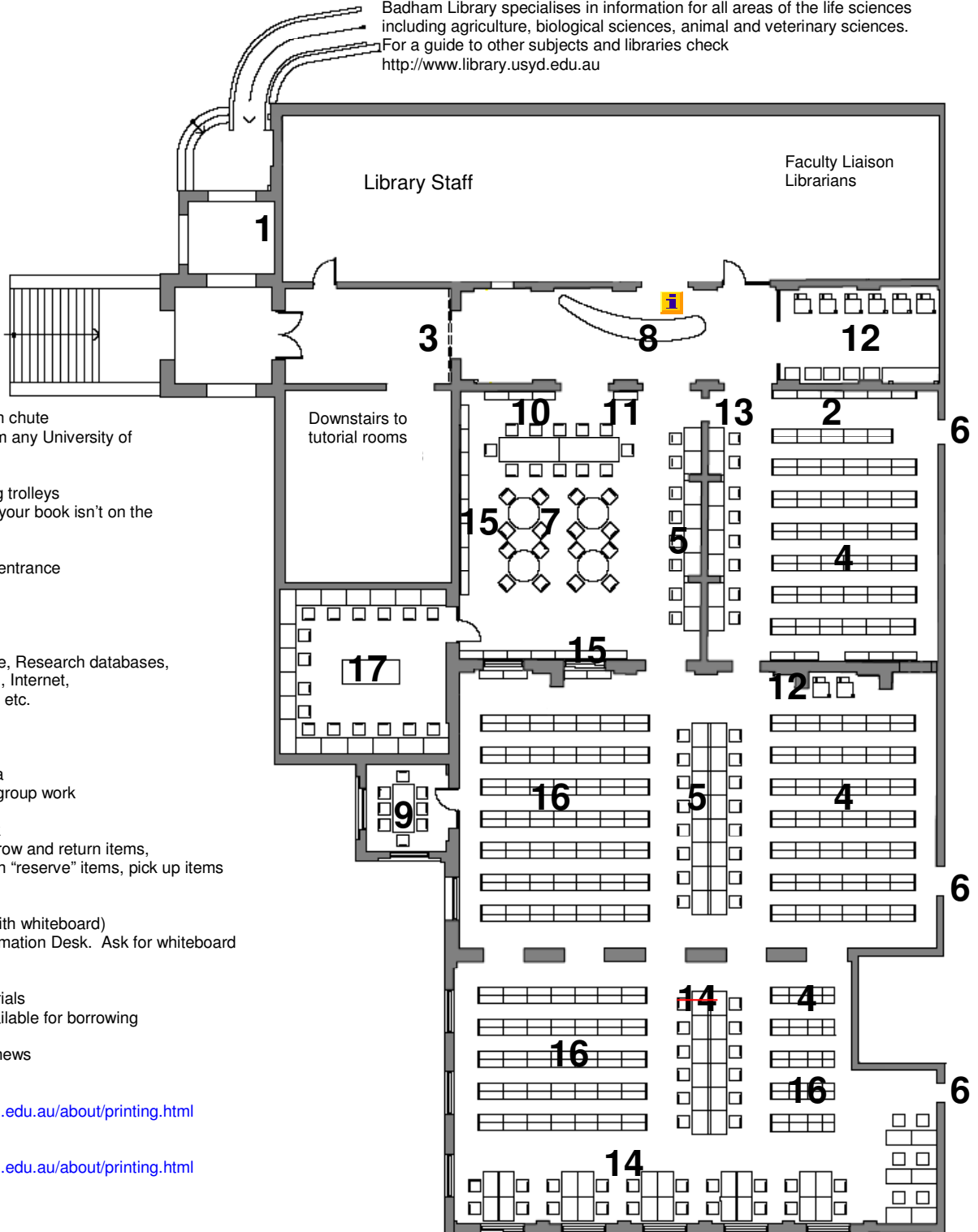


Badham Library Guide

6. Emergency exit
7. Group study area
Large tables for group work
8. Information Desk
Ask for help, borrow and return items, borrow and return "reserve" items, pick up items on "hold"
9. Meeting room (with whiteboard)
Book at the Information Desk. Ask for whiteboard markers

Latest books available for borrowing
11. Noticeboard for news
